## S-Shed Fruit Storage Terminal

### Project overview

Electrical services installation at an extensive 10m high storage building equivalent in size to 2 football pitches, operating as the main fruit storage facility at Bristol Port. Whitehead provided services that helped converted the existing building into a cold storage facility. Services included high voltage and general power distribution and internal/external lighting including systems designed to avoid the build-up of damaging condensation.

### Challenges

As a commercial project the sooner the facility was in operation the sooner it began making money, therefore the project was set tight deadlines. Safety was also a major factor with all the problems caused by working within a busy port.

### Solutions

WBS implemented an efficient, structured work plan alongside the main contractor and port authorities to ensure that the job was completed safely, within the allotted timeframe and to high quality standards.
