Project overview

Design and installation of Mechanical and Electrical services for this flagship, new style, 4 storey, 100 room Holiday Inn Express at Banbury, Milton Keynes. Mechanical services employed include air-conditioning, heating, hot and cold water, sanitary equipment/ systems and associated controls. The electrical installation included power, lighting, fire alarms, CCTV and access control along with a specifically designed voice evacuation system to promote panic free staged evacuations in the case of an emergency

Challenges

Hotel project challenges are driven by commercial pressures such as the need to provide maximum sellable space as soon as possible to a tight budget. These pressures inevitably result in a lack of space for services and a fixed, tight deadline for completion
