



LC2 (formerly Swansea Leisure Centre)

Project overview

Major Electrical Services project as part of a £32 million refurbishment of Swansea Leisure Centre now known as LC2. Designed to become one of Wales' most visited attractions the pool and sports facilities include the country's first 'surf rider', master blaster ride, 2 gravity flumes, a wave pool, lazy river and teaching lagoon. The project required the installation of 140 miles of cabling, 2021 lights, over 800 fire alarm devices and a specially designed PA sound system. The projects success resulted in Whitehead being awarded the Laing O'Rourke 'Supply Chain Performance of the Year' and the building being officially opened by The Queen in March 2008.

Challenges

This exciting development presented a huge logistical challenge with the installation of 'state of the art' products and associated services within the existing shell of the 1978 swimming pool building, all within a 50 week delivery programme.
