Project overview

An extensive and varied electrical services project within the retail/residential heart of the pioneering and award winning Mermaid Quay Waterfront, central to the re-development of Cardiff Bay. Services provided include the installation of extensive low voltage power supplies, sophisticated CCTV security management and monitoring systems and all lighting including low level and neon LED along the quayside.

Challenges

This complex infrastructure project set standards for this high profile redevelopment. Whitehead was tasked with achieving unusual and challenging specifications made more difficult by the nature derelict of the site.
