



Parc Y Scarlets

Project overview

A venue wide Electrical Services installation within the £24 million re-development of Parc Y Scarlets, the new 15000 seat capacity home of the Scarlets regional rugby team. The venue now includes athletics facilities, outdoor/indoor training academy, museum, public and corporate bars, players changing facilities, 14 hospitality boxes and a state of the art media suite. Services employed include the complete electrical distribution installation including under-pitch heating, the latest in floodlighting systems comprising 2 x 15m wishbones, CCTV surveillance, fire alarm and protection systems and a 'Green Guide' mains generator.

Challenges

With a 26 week project contract Whitehead faced major time constraints all focussed upon a 'no fail' program completion date of the 15th of November, the date of the first match to be played at the stadium.

Solutions

Whitehead met the deadline by immediately implementing a work development plan to manage the co-ordination of over 30 Whitehead tradespersons, other trades and the main contractor's construction personnel.
