Project overview

A substantial Electrical refurbishment and building extension fit-out at the WJEC (Welsh Joint Education Committee) building in Treforest, near Cardiff. The electrical services installed include internal and external lighting, fire alarms, security/data/power networks and a complete upgrade of the services within the existing building.

Challenges

The WJEC building houses facilities for Welsh exam papers, grade certificates, administration and marking services all of which are strictly confidential. As the building was operational during the project this presented many logistical challenges.

Solutions

Working in partnership with Carillion the Main Contractor Whitehead adopted a highly co-ordinated approach which involved a carefully planned sequence of operations for specific areas within the building whilst the work was carried out.
